Dear Mr. Shimrak,

Thank you for your inquiry about our application and subsequent bacteria-level data of Sterile Doctor at U.S. Cellular Field. The areas treated were our player clubhouses, certain areas of our front office, and dining room.

As you are aware we applied Sterile Doctor antimicrobial coating in January 2012. We decided it was in the best interest of our players and staff to protect them against any harmful microbes which can cause sickness, and particularly Pathogenic bacteria such as MRSA, STAPH, and E.Coli. As you know, Sterile Doctor continuously works 24/7 to inhibit the growth of such microbes.

Whereas we have a policy of not disclosing the actual bacteria-level scores to third-parties, I can tell you with certainty that some of our pre-application ATP meter levels were above the marginal level, and after the application of Sterile Doctor, our ATP meter levels immediately dropped to single digits in all areas treated.

I continue to measure these areas on a monthly basis, and the ATP meter scores have not increased over 100 and remain at sanitary levels between 0-100 in all treated areas. The White Sox staff, players, and most importantly the trainers are extremely pleased that we took the extra-step to ensure their daily and long-term wellbeing.

In addition, when the Sterile Doctor wipes become available, I plan on asking the appropriate staff if they would like to provide our players with these individual packets to take on road trips to wipe down airplane tables, arm rests and windows; and hotel room remote controls, headboards, phones etc.

Good luck with your representation of the Sterile Doctor product, I highly recommend it.
